



RULES AND REGULATIONS (Bye-Laws)

THE SASAS POST-GRADUATE BURSARY

1. The applicant

- 1.1 The applicant shall be at least a student member of the Society (apply electronically) who has graduated at a South African university or University of Technology. (Nationality is not a restriction).
- 1.2 The candidate must have qualified with at least a BSc (Agric.) in Animal Science or Animal Production or an Advanced Diploma in Animal Production (NQF8).
- 1.3 The applicant shall be a postgraduate student who must be registered to do an Honours or a Masters degree in Animal Science / Animal Production at a South African university or registered to do a MTech or DTech at a university of Technology.

2. Value and payment

- 2.1 Council shall decide on the amount payable to the successful applicant.
- 2.2 The bursary amount shall be paid in two instalments (one per year) directly to the successful candidate, on condition that his/her SASAS membership has not lapsed.

3. Conditions

- 3.1 This bursary is restricted to a study in a recognised animal science field at any university or university of technology in South Africa.
- 3.2 The bursary is awarded for exceptional academic performance (Cum Laude).
- 3.3 The applicant shall undertake to complete the Honours degree or MTech within two (2) years and the Masters degree or DTech within three (3) years.
- 3.4 In the case where the student fails to complete his study, SASAS preserves the right to claim the total amount plus ten per cent (10%) interest from the recipient. (Upon recommendation from promoter)
- 3.5 Due recognition of the bursary must be given in the thesis and in any publication accruing from the study.

4. Documents that shall accompany the application

- 4.1 A certified copy of the graduation certificate for degrees already acquired by the applicant.
- 4.2 A certified copy of an official statement of all subjects and symbols already completed, undergraduate as well as postgraduate as applicable.

5. Application form and closing date

- 5.1 The nomination form is available on the SASAS website or from the SASAS Secretary.
- 5.2 The closing date for the bursary application is 29 February 2024.
