✓ Required Supporting Documents

(Submit clear, certified copies where indicated. Missing documents may disqualify your application.)

- South African ID document (certified copy)
- Latest Matric results or Matric certificate
- University provisional acceptance letter (if currently in Matric)
- Full academic record, including recent transcript (on official institution letterhead)
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Motivational letter explaining why you deserve the bursary
- Tip: Your motivational letter should show your passion, commitment, and financial need. Make it personal and proofread carefully.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

You must meet all of the following:

- Be a South African citizen
- Be currently in Matric or have completed Matric
- Plan to study full-time towards a SAICA-accredited degree
- Be accepted to or intend to apply at a SAICA-accredited tertiary institution
- Have a strong academic record
- Be in financial need
- Be committed to your studies and future career

- Preference may be given to **Employment Equity (EE)** candidates, but all qualifying students are encouraged to apply
- **Note:** Always read the official bursary requirements on the provider's website. Some bursaries have unique criteria.

✓ Before You Submit

- Scan all documents clearly avoid blurry photos
- Ensure certified documents are not older than 3 months
- \square Proofread your CV and motivational letter
- \Box Check the bursary's **closing date** late applications are rejected
- \square Save a copy of your application and reference number (if available)
