Tell us who influenced you to study (e.g. yourself, your teachers, your parents, and/or a community leader) and how you will contribute to your community should you be successful in your studies.
- Character reference from teacher or community leader.
- Certified copy of South African ID **OR**
- Certified South African Department of Home Affairs Asylum Seekers Section 22 Permit **OR**
- Certified South African Department of Home Affairs Refugee Section 24 Permit **OR**
- Certified South African Department of Home Affairs Refugee ID **OR**
- Certified United Nations Convention Travel Document.

College applications must include the following documents: (Please ✓ as you complete)

- Full academic history (i.e. all results and competency tests scores)
- 3 months' salary/wage slips of bread-winner in the household OR affidavit confirming unemployment of bread-winner or SASSA grant income of bread-winner.
- Letter of motivation detailing why you want to study at a TVET college, what you want study and what your career and life-goals are. Tell us who influenced you to study (e.g. yourself, your teachers, your parents, a community leader), how you will contribute to your community should you be successful in your studies. Do you have any work experience, if so – tell us more about this.
- Certified copy of South African ID **OR**
- Certified South African Department of Home Affairs Asylum Seekers Section 22 Permit **OR**
- Certified South African Department of Home Affairs Refugee Section 24 Permit **OR**
